

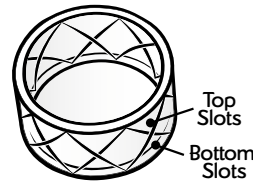
IN FULL BLOOM

CREATE LARGER-THAN-LIFE FLOWERS!

This kit includes all the materials you need to create the five flowers on pages 4-5. The rest of the book is filled with flowers to inspire you to design your own wallscapes.

COMPONENTS:

Five flower makers—Each flower maker has three parts.



Outer ring has two rows of slots, eight on top, eight on bottom.



Inner ring with hanger back



Lid

Precut printed petals for five flowers

They're printed on both sides!



Poppy



Chrysanthemum



Cornflower



Sunflower

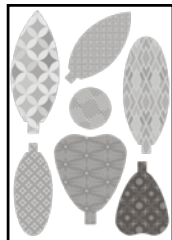


Daisy

Templates

Six different petal patterns, so you can make your own petals!

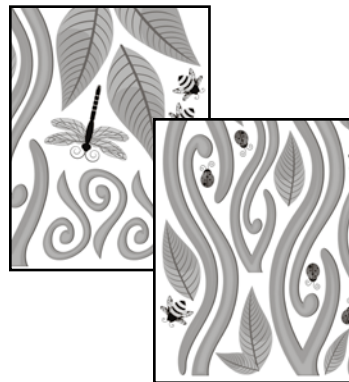
Use the positive pattern or the negative template.



Extras

Wall stickers—vines and leaves

Double-sided foam tape



PETAL POINTER:

Look for symbols throughout the book to see which petal patterns are used in the inspiration flowers.

PETAL POINTER:

When using paper or fabric with a pattern, use the template "negative" to frame the scene. Then trace and cut.

FLORAL ARRANGEMENT

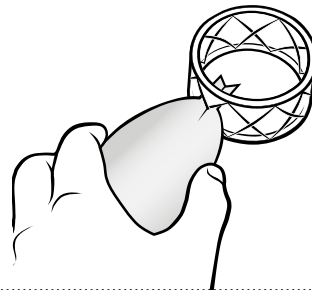


Punch out petals—or make your own!

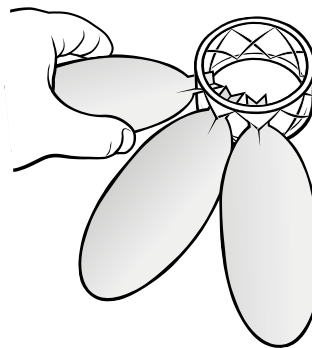
The sunflower and daisy both work like this basic flower, except they have two rows of petals.

PETAL POINTER:

For flowers with two rows of petals, fill the bottom row first, then the top row. The slots on top are offset from the ones on the bottom. This makes a fuller flower.



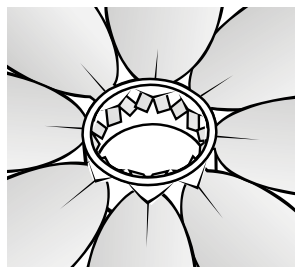
- * Set outer ring on a flat surface.
- * Squeeze petal slightly and slip its tabs into one of the top row slots.



- * Continue going around the flower, filling it in as you go. You can see it taking shape!

PETAL POINTER:

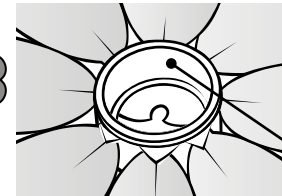
Keep the ring on the table and rotate after each petal: put in petal, rotate, put in petal, rotate, put in petal, rotate.



- * Peek to check that all petals are in place and not slipping out of their slots.

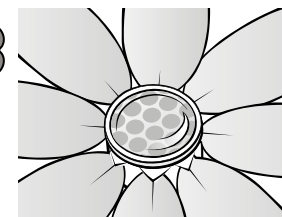
PETAL POINTER:

Fold the tabs down into the ring as you work to keep them secure.



- * Take the inner ring and gently push it into the outer ring.
- * Rock it gently back and forth if it gets stuck.

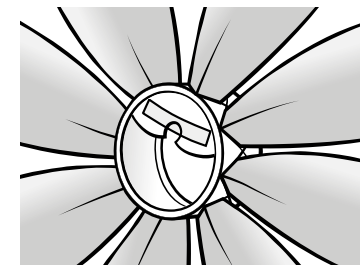
Inner Ring



- * Place paper into flower center lid, if you like.
- * Snap lid onto ring.

PETAL POINTER:

Any treatment you wish to do to the petals—curling, cutting, adding glitter—should be done before you insert them into the ring.



READY TO HANG!

Your kit comes with double-sided foam tape to hang your beauties on the wall. Ask an adult whether or not it's okay to use tape, thumbtacks, or nails on your wall.

In nature, the center of a flower is called the stigma.

THUMB TACK OR A NAIL:

- * Use the hanger to secure artwork. With a thumbtack, make sure it doesn't go into the wall all the way. You want the hanger to fit in between the head of the tack and the wall.
- * If you're having trouble, take off the center lid. It may be easier to hang if you can clearly see the hanger.

HE LOVES ME, HE LOVES ME NOT...

When you're ready to reuse a flower maker, remove the inner ring, then carefully pluck out the petals like you would a real flower.

GREEN LEAVES AND FINE VINES

To add even more dimension to your wallscapes, use greenery! The vines and leaves in this kit are stickers. Just stick them on your walls.
