

# SNAP TO IT!

All the projects in this book start with a basic snap.  
So snap to attention: here's how to make one!

1. CHOOSE A PIECE OF FABRIC. ONCE YOU'VE MADE A SNAP WITH THE FABRIC, IT'S DIFFICULT TO TAKE APART, SO CHOOSE WISELY!



IF YOU'RE USING A PRECUT FABRIC CIRCLE,  
SKIP TO STEP 3.

IF YOU'RE USING FABRIC THAT'S NOT PRECUT:

- ⓐ PLACE YOUR TRACING RING OVER THE SECTION OF THE FABRIC YOU WANT TO USE. WHAT YOU SEE INSIDE THE RING IS WHAT YOU'LL SEE ON THE SNAP.
- ⓑ TRACE THE OUTSIDE OF THE RING WITH A PEN OR PENCIL.
- ⓒ CUT OUT YOUR CIRCLE. IT DOESN'T HAVE TO BE PERFECT!



In the fabric world,  
the "right-side"  
is the side you  
want to show.

PUT YOUR FABRIC CIRCLE RIGHT-SIDE DOWN IN THE  
FRAMED OPENING OF YOUR SNAP MAKER.  
PUT A DOME OVER IT, ROUND-SIDE DOWN.



PRESS DOWN THE ARM OF THE SNAP MAKER.



RAISE ARM. THEN TUCK THE EXTRA FABRIC  
INTO THE CENTER OF THE DOME.  
PLACE A BACK ON THE SNAP MAKER, AS SHOWN.



PRESS DOWN THE ARM OF YOUR SNAP MAKER,  
UNTIL YOU HEAR AND FEEL A CLICK.



PUSH THE RELEASE BUTTON. LIFT UP THE ARM.  
YOU CAN PULL THE SNAP OFF THE ARM.
