


## **SEASONAL SNOWFLAKE**

The snowflake is a seasonal symbol of the holiday spirit, but did you know that in nature, there are no two exactly alike? Here's your chance to make a totally unique snowflake of your own.

- 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper, any color or style Scissors
- · Art supplies (markers, colored pencils, glitter, etc.)
  - Your imagination and some patience!

## Fold the left section upwards, then fold the right section upwards.

Flip the shape over so that the horizontal edge is facing up. Cut along the horizontal edge so that you end up with an inverted triangle.




While keeping the triangle folded, cut random shapes out of the edges.




Gently open up the paper to reveal a unique 6-pointed snowflake!






NSTRUCTION

Turn any rectangular piece of paper into a square by folding the top right corner diagonally down to meet the paper's left edge. Cut excess paper to reveal a square.



Fold the triangle across the middle to make a smaller triangle.
